



## 13 Risks of Using Machine and Al Translation on Sensitive Documents

### LEGAL RISKS







## Liability for Al Errors

Companies are legally responsible for Algenerated translation mistakes (e.g., false advertising or misrepresentation).

Always verify Al outputs before publication.







### Invalid or Rejected Documents

Courts and official institutions often reject machine-translated contracts or submissions.

Use certified human translators for legal or immigration documents.







#### Misinterpretation of Legal Terms

Al can mistranslate legal phrases, leading to serious misunderstandings or case errors.

Ensure a qualified professional reviews legal terminology.








## Impact on Immigration and Asylum Cases

Translation errors can alter names, dates, or pronouns, risking denial of protection or benefits.

Double-check all translated personal and legal details.





# DATA SECURITY RISKS







## Exposure of Sensitive Information

Al tools may store or reuse uploaded content.

Avoid inputting confidential or client data into online AI systems.







## GDPR and Privacy Compliance

Using global AI services can breach data protection laws.

Confirm compliance with GDPR and local privacy regulations.







## Hallucinations and Fabrications

Al may generate false or misleading content.

Always cross-verify Al translations with trusted sources.







#### Cloud Storage Vulnerabilities

Cloud-based Al tools may store data on remote servers.

Use secure, approved platforms for sensitive information.







#### Data Leakage

Al models can unintentionally memorize and reproduce private data.

Limit the amount of personal data shared with AI tools.







## Overcollection and Secondary Use

Some Al systems collect more data than necessary.

Review privacy policies and restrict data sharing.







#### Prompt Injection Attacks

Malicious prompts can trick Al into revealing confidential data.

Train staff to recognize and avoid unsafe Al interactions.







#### Opaque Data Usage

Al data processing may lack transparency.

Maintain documentation of data sources and consent.







#### Biometric Data Breaches

Al tools using facial or voice recognition store unchangeable identifiers.

Protect biometric data with the highest security standards.







## Summary of Best Practices

- Always use a professional translator with subject-matter expertise for legal and financial documents.
- Ask providers detailed questions about how they handle data security.
- Maintain control of your translation memories and final deliverables.
